IMPORTANT YOUR DIRECT-DIALING TELEPHONE NUMBER

INCOMING CALLS

You can assist in speeding up incoming telephone calls by asking people who call you to do so by using your WO number. For example, when leaving word for someone locally to call or dial you, if your extension number is 34111 give it as "WO 34111." (People in the government should call you by dialing code 13 and your 5 digit extension number.)

OUTGOING CALLS LOCAL OUTGOING CALLS

No change has been made in the method of making local outgoing calls. Dial 9 then dial the number you are calling or all local outgoing calls.

LONG DISTANCE OUTGOING CALLS ON COMMERCIAL LINES

When placing Long Distance calls on commercial lines dial 301 and give your WO (34111) number, and not WORTH 3-1110 Extension 34111 to the "Charge Operator" when she comes in on the line. Immediately after completion of the call fill out SEC Form-65 and submit to Office of Comptroller - Room 137**.

LONG DISTANCE OUTGOING CALLS ON GOVERNMENT DIRECT LINES (FTS)

Government telephony Direct Long Distance Dialings are provided for employees of the FTS Federal Government structure system guide.

1. To place a call Dial 8.
2. When you hear the 2nd Dial tone dial the area code and the distant number.
3. All collect calls are made on commercial lines Dial 0.
4. All local calls Dial 9.
5. Remember to make out a ticket for all long distance calls and be sure to place the Identification Number, 03-50-00-000, on the ticket for billing purposes.
6. Use your FTS telephone Guide on all Long Distance calls.
7. Keep an adequate list of frequently called numbers.

8. Call extension 3-4204. If you have any questions concerning FTS.
9. PERSONAL CALLS.

Local or long distance personal calls over Government telephones are not permitted. PLEASE USE THE PAY TELEPHONES IN ROOM 137.

TO TRANSFER CALLS

To transfer all long distance incoming calls, depress the handset, change of switchhook for one second and dial extension number. When the operator comes through the intercom request her to transfer the call.

INTEROFFICE CALLS

Use directory for extension numbers. If party is not listed dial 33201 for information. DO NOT dial Operator and part for individual.

INTERDEPARTMENTAL CALLS

Consult the dial code (Page 17) for the Agency Code number. If you know the Agency extension number of the person you are calling, dial the Agency Code number and then dial the extension number. If there is no second dial tone, If you do not know the extension of the person you are calling, dial the Agency Code and then dial "01" (operator) for information. EXAMPLE: FOR CALLS TO THE LIBRARY OF CONGRESS Dial Code 173, then dial "01" (Operator) for the information Operator. The information Operator will give you the number of the person you are calling. Hang-up. Then dial the Agency Code and the extension number of your party. If the Agency code is "13" (Same as S.E.C.), dial only "01" (Operator) for information Operator. PLEASE RECORD the number for future reference.

TELEPHONE COURTESY

1. Answer your telephone promptly, after the first ring. Promptness indicates that you respect the time of the person who is calling you.
2. When you answer your telephone, announce who you are. For example, "Incoming Mail, Mr. Henry speaking." A call should never be answered by a mere "Hello."
3. Speak distinctly, pleasantly, and in a natural tone of voice.
4. Request identity of caller only when necessary; then in a tactful manner, as:
"May I have your name, please?"
"May I tell him who is calling?"
"May I ask who is calling, please?"
5. Explain off-the-line delays. "The information you want is in our files. May I have your number and call you back?"
6. If you have more than one phone to answer and you are already on one line when the second telephone rings, don't let the second telephone ring incessantly. This annoys both you and the caller. Excuse yourself, place one line on "hold" and answer the other. If the matter is brief, handle it. If it is not, tell the person you will call back promptly unless the caller prefers to wait, then go back to the first call.
7. If you receive calls which are not for you, be sure that you have the correct number, and then transfer the call.
8. When you make a telephone call, announce who you are. Never expect the person you have called or the one calling you to know your voice or who you are. Most of the time he can only guess.
9. If you request a call back, give your branch and code number and the best time to call you. Example: "Please ask Mr. Thatcher to call Mr. Blackstone, Code 13, Extension 22468."
10. If you dial the wrong number be courteous; excuse yourself before hanging up the telephone.
11. If you are going to be away from your desk or office, arrange to have your calls answered.
12. Stay on the line when making or receiving long distance calls.
13. Courtesy at your end of the line generates cooperation at the other.
